*Raspberry Cordial*

3 pints raspberries  
3 pints boiling water  
3 lbs. sugar  
Juice of 1 lemon


Let berries stand in boiling water 24 hours. Strain through bag. Add sugar and lemon juice. Boil 10 minutes. Bottle while hot.

Fragrant and Soothing

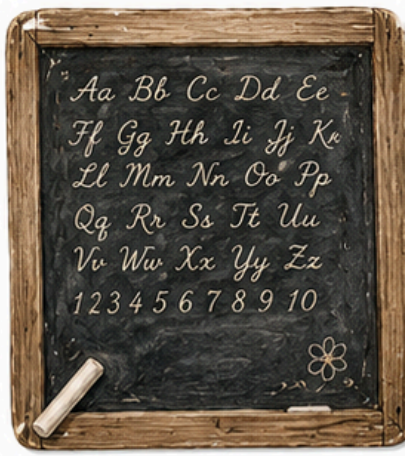
*Apple Butter*

1/2 tsp. cloves

Cook apples until soft. Press through sieve. Add sugar and spices. Cook slowly until thick. Stir often.
